### **MINUTES**

Minutes of the meeting of Ellerton and Aughton Parish Council held on Tuesday 28<sup>th</sup> January 2025 at 7.30pm at the Village Hall.

#### **Public Session:**

Clearance of trees adjacent to the Main Street - Back Lane loop: a lot of the vegetation has been removed but as this is private land, the Parish Council do not have any control over this matter currently.

Ditch and Pond - it was reported that the CSO is still discharging although the rain has not been excessive and that the water is running clear. An EIR Request has been made for everything that has been discharged into the pond during 2024. Ownership of the dyke is still uncertain. Cllr Hunter will pursue this. **AH**

Any solids are the responsibility of Yorkshire Water. The Parish Council will flail the dyke and keep the sides tidy.

Water testing kits are on order. Readings will be taken every 3-4 weeks and monitored throughout the year. It was noted that the Environment Agency declined to come and do any testing so the Parish Council has taken this on. Any further action required will be taken on once the scientific analysis is available.

Cllr Hunter expressed the Parish Council's appreciation to Mrs M Wilson , Mr D Wilson and Mr R Hill for their efforts.
